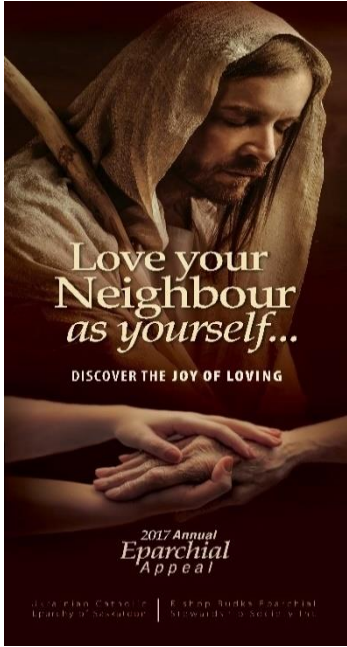

On July 1, 2017, after 27 years at Ottawa's Saint Paul University, the **Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky Institute of Eastern Christian Studies** is relocating to Toronto where it will be an autonomous academic unit of the **Faculty of Theology** of the **University of St. Michael's College** in the **University of Toronto**, and will participate in the esteemed consortium known as the **Toronto School of Theology**.

The Faculty of Theology will offer the following degrees, conjointly with the University of Toronto, through the Sheptytsky Institute with a specialization in Eastern Christian Studies:

- two professional **Basic Degree** programs, the **Master of Theological Studies (MTS)** and **Master of Divinity (MDiv)**
- four **Advanced Degree** programs, the professional **Master of Theology (ThM)** and **Doctor of Ministry (DMin)** and the research-oriented **MA** and **PhD** in Theology

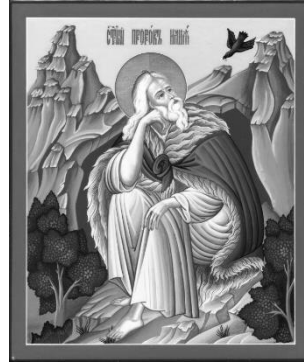

without end. The time and place of the funeral celebrations will be announced shortly.

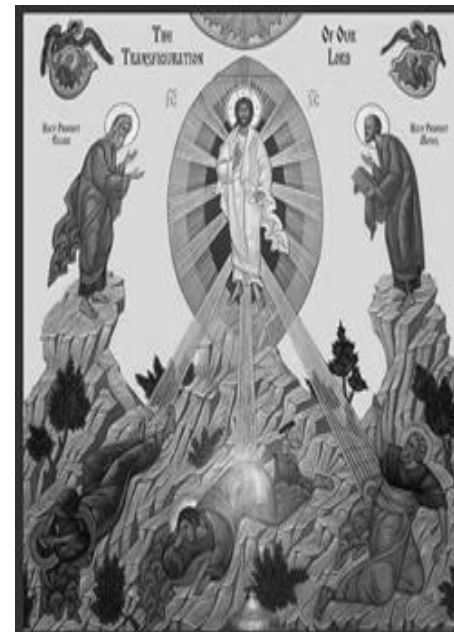
