
Our Gospel today from the Gospel of John, on this the Sunday of Christ the Lover of Mankind, contains a line which many of us know very well; in fact, it is contained in the Eucharistic Prayer of our own Divine Liturgy: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten so that those who believe may have eternal life." Many Christians know John 3:16 by memory, for it is the foundation of the Christian faith, but few know, let alone live as if they believe, the next verse -- John 3:17: 'GOD SENT NOT HIS SON INTO THE WORLD TO CONDEMN THE WORLD, BUT THAT THE WORLD, THROUGH HIM, MIGHT BE SAVED.'

I'm often shocked and surprised by how many of us think that God would condemn us. Why? Where do we pick up these messages? God does not condemn people. If that were so, He could have done that quite easily through Jesus when He sent Him to earth. But He didn't. God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world.

We, as humans, find it difficult to understand such a loving reaction from a Holy God. We are often much too quick to find faults and shortcomings when we find someone falling short of our expectations. Our good news is that God does for us that which we cannot do for ourselves: Not to condemn. Although our pride, our silly presumption about ourselves deserves condemnation, we receive not condemnation, but salvation. Our great sense of direction in life is but our stumbling in the dark, much as Nicodemus may have been trying to find the light through Christ. Into our darkness, Christ brings us light, shows us the way to eternal life.
