Glory to Jesus Christ!

Next Sunday, we will celebrate the Feast of Pentecost – 50 days after Easter. In the epistle reading for the Feast from the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2.1-11), we read that the Holy Spirit manifests itself as a 'strong driving wind', 'tongues of fire', and a 'variety of languages'. In our Byzantine Tradition, the colour green is also significant because Pentecost commemorates the new life that the Holy Spirit gives to us as Church, and the corresponding new life we see around us in these days of spring (hence why green vestments are worn at Liturgy for the Feast).

With that in mind, I'm inviting you and/or your family to participate in our **Parish Pentecost Activity**. Please take a picture or video of yourself and/or your family which incorporates one or all of the four Pentecost themes: **wind**, **fire**, **multiple languages** and the **colour green**, and send it to <u>dormitionparishsaskatoon@gmail.com</u> so it can be included in our parish Pentecost Video. For example, in your video you may be wearing green, holding a candle, saying 'Glory to Jesus Christ!'' and/or "Cлaba Icycy Xpиcty!'' (our liturgical greeting for the Season of Pentecost), with the wind blowing through your hair! Or it might be as simple as taking a photo of yourself in front of a tree in your backyard. Don't be afraid to participate and be creative! Deadline for submitting your photo or video to <u>dormitionparishsaskatoon@gmail.com</u> is this **Friday, May 29**. Don't forget to include your name(s) with your photo or video.

This Saturday, May 30th at 11:00AM, on the Eve of Pentecost, our children will have an opportunity to attend a special **Zoom Children's Liturgy**, where they will learn more about the Feast of Pentecost and have a chance to share their Pentecost 'wind-catcher'. This past week, the Government of Saskatchewan announced that on June 8th, indoor public gatherings may increase up to 15 people. With that in mind, the Eparchy of Saskatoon will soon be announcing directives for gradually re-opening our churches in concert with these Provincial guidelines, including strict restrictions on numbers attending, requirements for physical distancing, and a modified process for receiving Holy Communion. Know that our parish is developing a system so you and your family can sign-up to come to church.

Cemetery services (grave blessings) in Saskatoon will be held this year as follows: **Sunday, June 7th at 2:00PM at Woodlawn Cemetery** (1502 2nd Ave North) and **Sunday, June 14th at 2:00PM at Hillcrest Cemetery** (210 Wess Road). Due to COVID-19 restrictions, there will be no gathered Panakhyda service before the blessings - families are asked to wait for the priest at the grave of their loved one or in their car, limit attendees to no more than 10 persons, and maintain physical distancing of two metres from other parties.
