Glory to Jesus Christ!

At a bowling alley, two men were talking about marriage. One man said, "My wife and I argue a lot, and every time we argue she gets historical. His friend interrupted him, "You meant to say that she gets hysterical, didn't you?" The first man responded, "No, when my wife and I argue, she doesn't get hysterical; she gets historical. She drags up everything from the past and holds it against me!"

I wonder if some of us are excessively "historical" in our relationships. With pinpoint accuracy, some of us can recall every bad thing that has ever happened to us and the smallest details surrounding each event. Perhaps you cannot anticipate the future or enjoy the present because you are imprisoned by the pain of your past. The solution: **forgiveness**. Now, if you don't like the word forgive for this, use another phrase like "let go" or "break free"; but allow yourself to be free from the past hurt and pain that has gone on without reconciliation.

This is another two-week bulletin, including Liturgies and events in our pastoral district up until August 30th. 
